## TOWN OF BARRE NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

The Town of Barre will hold a public hearing on July 10, 2024 at 6:30 pm at the Town Hall located at 14317 West Barre Road, Albion, New York 14411 for the purpose of hearing public comments on the Town of Barre's Water District No. 10 community development needs, and to discuss the possible submission of one or more Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) applications for the 2024 program year. The CDBG program is administered by the New York State Office of Community Renewal (OCR) and will make available to eligible local governments approximately \$25,000,000 for the 2024 program year for housing, economic development, public facilities, public infrastructure, and planning activities with the principal purpose of benefitting low/moderate income persons. The Town of Barre is applying for 2,000,000 in CDBG funds for the installation of Water District No. 10. The hearing will provide further information about the CDBG program, including progress towards beneficiary goals and program objectives, and will allow for citizen participation in the development of any proposed grant applications and/or to provide technical assistance to develop alternate proposals. Comments on the CDBG program or proposed project will be received at this time. The hearing is being conducted pursuant to Section 570.486, Subpart 1 of the CFR and in compliance with the requirements of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, as amended.
